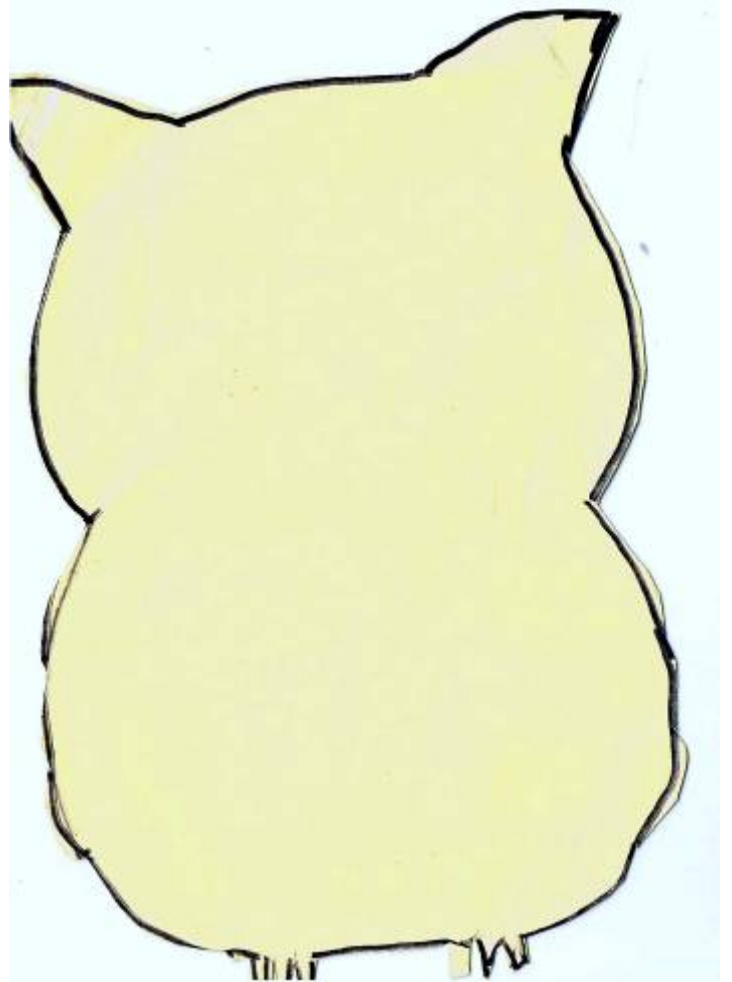

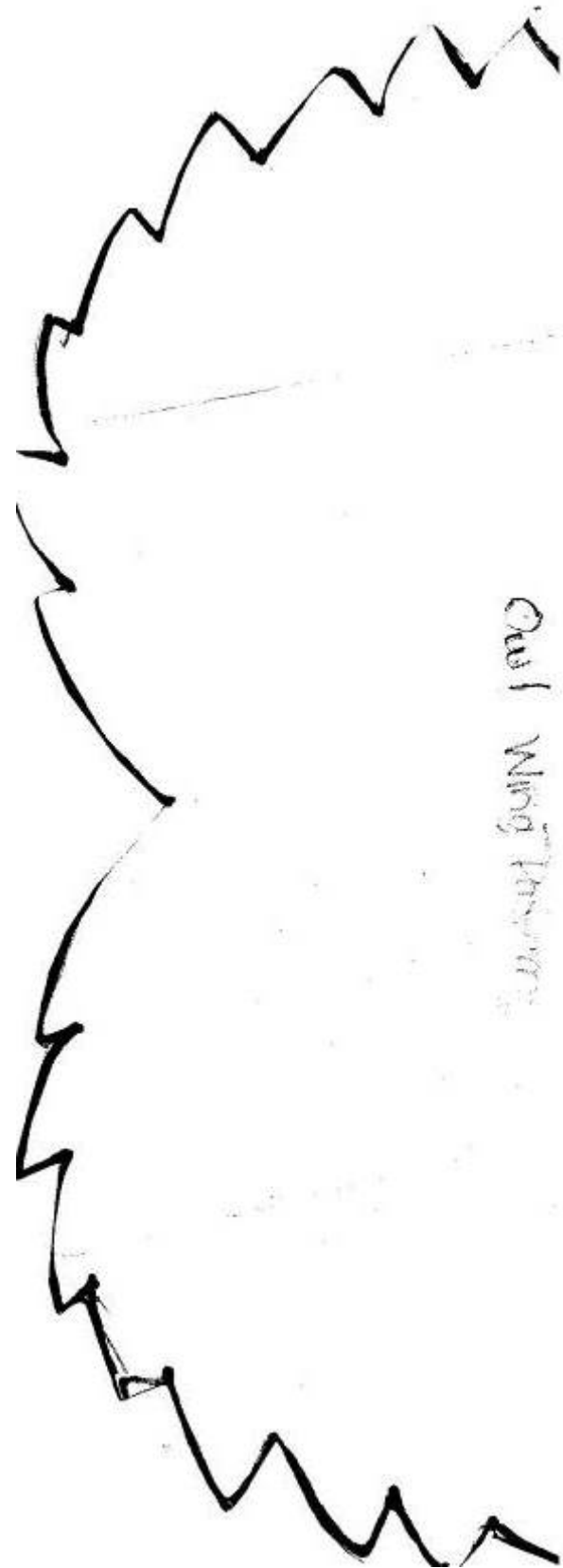
## Patterns and Examples of Owl Activities

Pattern can be enlarged or reduced to suit your activity. Gives one an idea how to draw an outline of owl .



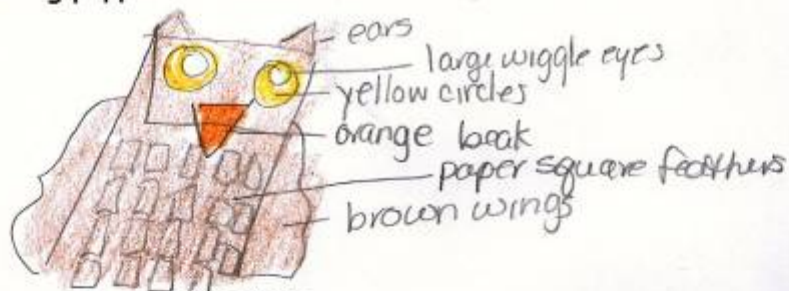
1990's. We blew this up larger and the children added orange beak and large wiggle eyes.

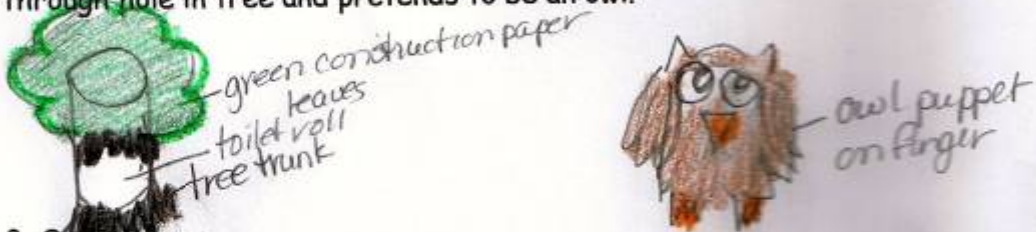
## Patterns and Examples of Owl Activities

### 1. Owl bag puppet or stuffed Owl in a bag



### 2. Finger puppet owl in a tree

Use toilet tissue roll. Paint it brown or black or glue/tape on construction paper. Then add a brown/black tree trunk and green paper for tree leaves. Cut a hole in toilet tissue roll. Make a finger puppet with pattern provided, one can make a small owl outline, add eyes and beak or point index finger (or use brown marker) add tiny wiggle eyes, ears, and beak. Child puts finger through hole in tree and pretends to be an owl.



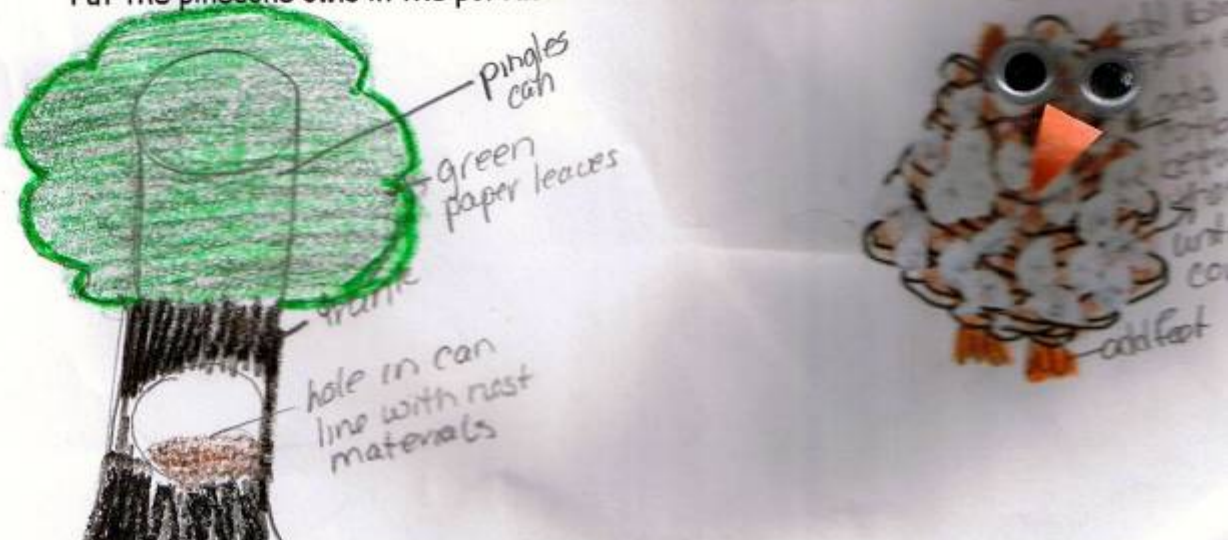
### 3. Owl in tree :

#### The tree:

Use a Pringles can and cover it with brown or black construction paper. Then cut out a hole add a brown or black tree trunk, add nesting material (dried leaves, grass, twigs) and line the inside of can.

#### Pine cone Owl:

Take a small pinecone and put small pieces of cotton between the layers of pine seeds until it filled with cotton. Add paper beak, ears, and feet. Put the pinecone owls in the portable trees that the children can carry home.
