Some animals hibernate or sleep in winter.

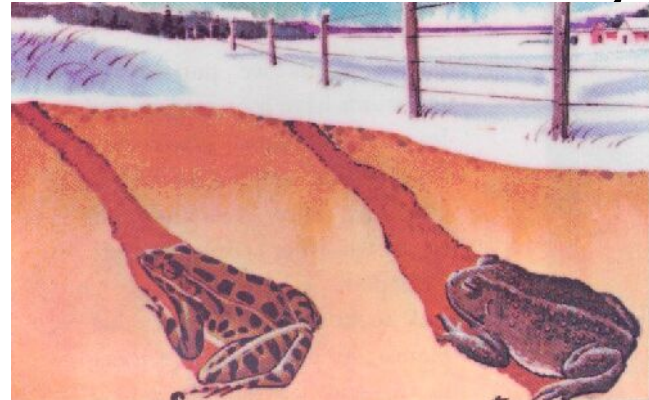


This is a bear.

This is a hedgehog.



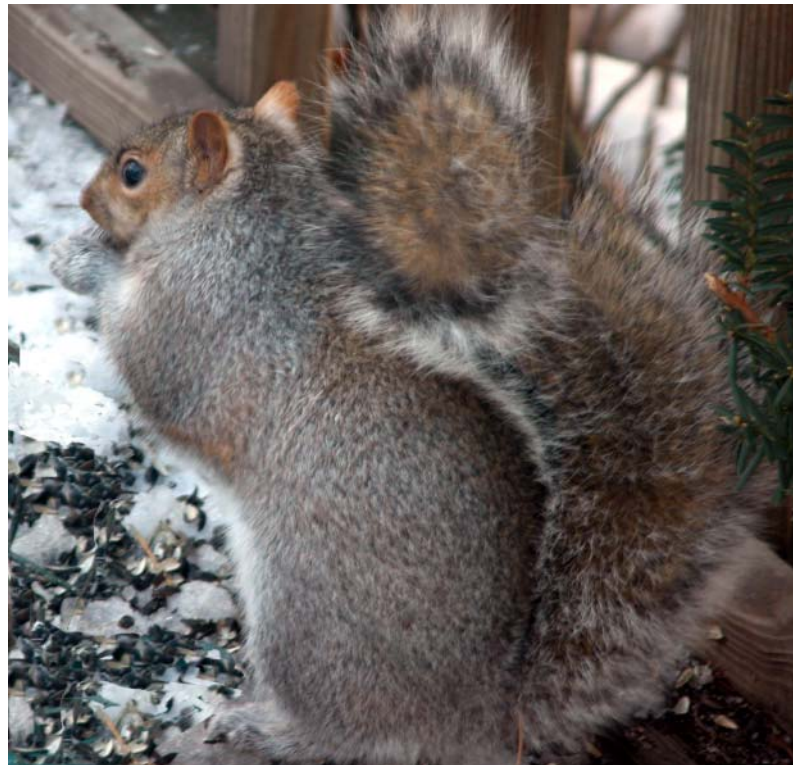
Some animals stay awake all winter and grow thick fur to keep them warm.

Some birds take vacations in winter by flying south where it is warm.

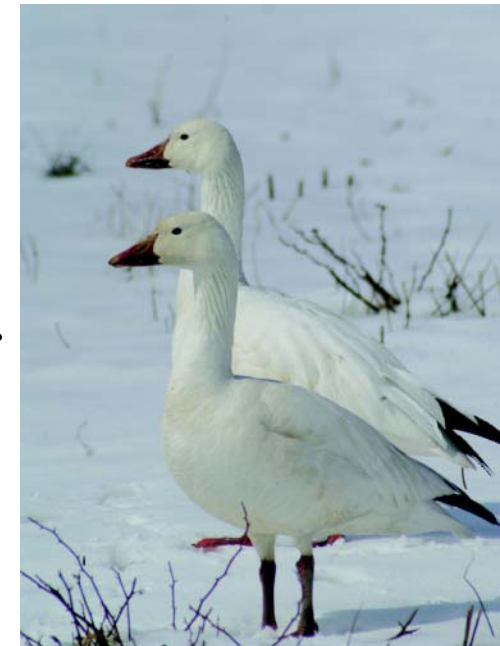
This is a duck.
